



# ST. ELIZABETH of the Trinity

Dear Parents,

As we approach a holiday weekend, please be aware of the Travel Advisory. We follow the Chicago Travel Advisory and most of the states are in the "orange" which means any UNVACCINATED student(s) traveling to an orange state will either need to quarantine for 10 days or pre-send a negative COVID test taken no earlier than 72 hours prior to returning to Chicago.

Vaccinated students do not need any quarantining or negative tests as long as students are not symptomatic AND provide proof of vaccination.

Any student who is vaccinated does not need to quarantine if they come in close contact with a person who tests positive for COVID. However, in order to avoid a quarantine, proof of vaccination needs to be on file. If your student(s) are vaccinated, please send in a copy of their vaccination card. These cards will be filed away and the only ones to know the vaccination status of your student(s) are Ms. Czyz and myself. Turning in a card is completely voluntary, but it could save time later if a quarantine is necessary.

**St. Elizabeth of the Trinity School and Parish** will be hosting a vaccination clinic on October 2nd (1st dose) and October 23rd (2nd dose) for any students or adults interested. It will be open to the public as well. More information to follow.
